Proposal to celebrate the CHILDREN'S DAY

Introduction:

To gather all information in a power point presentation.

Our Learners will be involved in planning a tourist tour of main places of children interest with the participation of their nephews and nieces.

They will also work together to make comics using the main themes of that special day.
